

# **The 2010 Mission Schedule:**

**Dates of Trip: April 10-17**

## **Thursday, April 8:**

Drop off all gear and tools after 3:00 pm but no later than 7:00 pm to the Creekside building. The only things that don't get dropped off are your San Diego bag and personal tools. Even drivers need to drop their stuff off on Thursday since their vehicle will have to carry San Diego bags and perhaps some group gear.

## **Friday, April 9:**

9:30 am Volunteers come to LAUMC to go pick up vans.  
10:00 am Service Rent-a-Car is expecting us to arrive  
1:00 pm Pack gear, tools, and food in vans (and private vehicles if necessary)  
afternoon Drivers of private vehicles stop by if possible to get vehicle number put on their car and see if group gear needs to go in their vehicle; private vehicle drivers fill their own tanks with gas

## **Saturday, April 10:**

8:15 am Drivers' meeting; driver packets handed out with maps, lists, etc.  
8:30 am Gather at LAUMC; get a vehicle list; find your assigned vehicle  
9:00 am Leave for San Diego; drink water all day  
12 noon Lunch stop along Highway 5 – check in with Leslie by walkie-talkie  
7:00 pm Arrive at hotel in San Diego - Old Town Inn

Evening each vehicle on their own for dinner (you can walk to Old Town)

## **Sunday, April 11:**

Before 8:00 eat in hotel's "Breakfast Room" next to lobby  
8:00 am gather in lobby; check out of hotel, drive to church (except food shoppers)  
9:00 am Worship at - University Christian Church

10:30 am Buy your lunch to go at Farmer's Market across from church and proceed to border crossing; drink water all day; have your ID with you;  
12:30 pm arrive at Amor Ministries with full gas tank; park along side street; make last potty stop, eat your lunch  
1:00 pm AMOR check-in & drivers' meeting  
2:00 pm AMOR will escort us across border. No playing with walkie talkies near border; stay quietly in cars.  
3:00 pm Set up camp.  
6:00 pm dinner, campfire and bed

## **Monday through Thursday, April 12-15:**

6:45 am Breakfast; each person makes their own lunch & puts it in team cooler; each person fills their personal water container (from igloos) and sun shower (from barrels)  
7:30 am Gather & proceed to building sites and Build Houses!  
12 noon Lunch on site.

- 5:00 pm Back to camp for showers, dinner, campfire and bed. Team coolers emptied & returned to kitchen and igloos get refilled
- Friday, April 16:**
- 8:00 am Break camp and head for the border.
- 12 noon Lunch and some type of low key activity in San Diego – or - swimming & massages at hotel.
- 3:00 pm Check in time for same San Diego hotel.
- 6:00 pm Gather by the pool for pizza.
- Saturday, April 17:**
- Before 8:30 eat in hotel's "Breakfast Room"
- 8:30 am Check out of hotel and leave for Los Altos. (If your car leaves earlier, check out with Leslie)
- 5:00 pm Arrive at LAUMC; **everyone** takes **all** their own gear home and helps put group gear in basement; **people who travel home separately must be there or have someone there to pick up their stuff**
- Sunday, April 18:**
- 12:00 pm volunteers return washed vans to Service Rent-a-Car before they close at 1pm
- Sunday, April 25:**
- 1:00 pm volunteers clean equipment and pack it into basement

## CAMP RULES

1. Wear shoes all the time. Flip flops are allowed only to/from showers.
2. Do not leave our camp site without telling an adult. You may go to the Camp Store or to visit at another camp site – no where else. Do not enter another site without an invitation.
3. Do not throw rocks.
4. Quiet hours are 10 pm to 6 am. You should be in your tent and quiet during quiet hours.
5. Take shower water from the barrels for your sun shower. Do not waste water. Do not drink shower water.
6. Brush your teeth with the drinking water.
7. Wash hands after bathroom, after shower and before eating. Use sanitizer. Shake your hands dry or bring a bandana to dry them.
8. Drink mixes are for drinking, not for eating dry.
9. Clean up after yourself.
10. Chairs are "communal" unless the chair's owner asks to sit in it.
