



Mississippi Hurricane Relief Trip

Help us to heal hearts and homes January 30-February 5, 2011

There are still homes to repair and rebuild following the devastation from Hurricane Katrina on August 29, 2005. Come with us as we help people move from temporary housing into safe, sanitary and secure homes.

Who's invited: All men and women with home improvement/construction experience. Membership in Los Altos United Methodist Church is not a requirement.

What will we do? Home rehabilitation and new home construction

Where will we stay: Dormitory-style facilities that have been set up by the Mississippi Conference Disaster Response Center in North Gulfport at Camp Love.

What will it cost? Estimated cost is \$800 including air fare, rental vans, gas, insurance and food. A \$400 deposit is due with the Reservation Form. \$530 of this estimated \$800 cost is the air fare. If air fares increase, the cost may be higher. The balance due will be invoiced after the purchase of airline tickets.

How do I sign up? Complete a Reservation Form and turn it in with a \$400 deposit to LAUMC by November 22, 2010. Space is limited to 20 people.
